2018 REGISTRATION and the NEW PROACTIVE MANAGEMENT-BASED REGULATION (PMBR) INITIATIVE

When registration for the 2018 registration year begins in October 2017, lawyers in private practice who do not have malpractice will be required to complete a four-hour, on-line self-assessment course regarding the operation of their law firm pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 756(e). The course will be presented in several parts and can be taken over the course of a year but must be completed before the 2019 registration unless malpractice is obtained before then. The course is open to all lawyers who may take any part of or the entire course for CLE credit.
